The Consent Agenda is considered routine in nature and non-controversial. Consent Items include minutes, reports, tax property sales, and bid awards for expenditures previously approved in the budget. The Consent Agenda can be acted upon in one motion or individual items may be removed from the consent agenda for individual discussion by a Council Member, Board Member, Executive Director, or the City Manager.

Taxpayer Impact Statement:

For a median-valued homestead in the City of Borger, the estimated City property tax bill for Fiscal Year 2026 is **\$407.05**, based on a median taxable value of **\$67,080** and the current tax rate of **\$0.606807 per \$100 valuation**.

For Fiscal Year 2027, the estimated City property tax bill on a median-valued homestead with a taxable value of **\$72,820** would be **\$470.85** if the proposed budget is adopted, based on the proposed tax rate of **\$0.646590 per \$100 valuation**

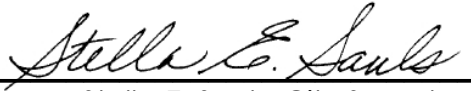
If the City instead adopted a balanced budget funded at the no-new-revenue tax rate of **\$0.601693 per \$100 valuation**, the estimated property tax bill would be **\$438.15**.
